**NEW QUARTERLY DATA REPORT FORMAT**

Welcome to the new-look quarterly data reports! The quarterly reports have changed in appearance to reflect changes made by the federal Children's Bureau with new measures and composites. The data contained in the quarterly report is transitional at this point, and does not include data for all of the new composite measures.

The seventeen federal outcome measures for the second round of the Children and Family Services Review, along with other measures to support the California Child Welfare Services Outcomes System, will be available in the next several months. We anticipate that the remaining Composite Two (adoption) measures and the new Composite Three (long term care) measures will be up and running with either the October 2007 or January 2008 quarterly reports.

Analyses run on prior data extracts will remain on the static web pages of the Child Welfare Services/Case Management System Reports section of the UC Berkeley web site available at [<http://cssr.berkeley.edu/cwscmsreports/defaultStatic.asp>] for as long as users find the information helpful.

A word of caution:

DO NOT COMPARE PERFORMANCE TO THE OLDER QUARTERLY REPORTS.
