Item/Definition Clarifications

- ▣ Period Under Review
 - Generally: From the designated PUR start until the day you begin the ratings in OMS or case closure



Item/Definition Clarifications

- ▣ End of PUR Considerations
 - Review ends when you begin to rate the items
 - Review ends when the case is closed
 - Return home from Foster Care
 - Multiple cases/episodes



Item/Definition Clarifications

- ▣ Item 12
 - ACF Reviewer Brief
 - Return home from Foster Care
 - Multiple cases/episodes



Online Monitoring System (OMS)

- ▣ De-identification
 - De-identification of FINALIZED cases will begin on January 29th.
 - No need to select the secondary oversight at this time
