This workshop will review the new Federal Case Review tool, which is used to:
1) ensure child welfare conformity with federal requirements; 2) determine what is actually happening to children and families engaged in child welfare services; and 3) assist the state and county to enhance capacity to help children and families achieve positive outcomes.
This intensive, four-day workshop will prepare staff with the materials needed to successfully conduct the California Child and Family Review (C-CFSR) process.

- Synthesize information from a variety of sources (organizing data in such a way that they can use the information in the tool)
