## Child and Family Services Review Program Improvement Plan Kick-Off

The Child and Family Services Reviews (CFSR) is a federally required effort designed to help ensure that quality services are provided to children and families through child welfare systems. The reviews identify strengths and areas needing improvement in programs and systems by focusing on outcomes for children and families in the areas of safety, permanency, and child and family well-being. Each round of the CFSR involves the following process: 1) Statewide Assessment; 2) Onsite Reviews and Stakeholder Interviews; and 3) Program Improvement Plan (PIP). Currently, California is in round two of the CFSR at the development phase of a PIP to address areas needing improvement.

The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) invites you to join child welfare stakeholders from around the State to kick-off the development of the PIP to:

- Learn about the Child and Family Services Reviews process
- Gain information on the federal findings of the Statewide Assessment and Onsite Review
- Contribute your ideas about California's Program Improvement Plan
