Orientation For the Core Practice Model and the Medi-Cal Manual

Course Description

The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) and the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) in collaboration with the Resource Center for Family Focused Practice and the California Institute for Mental Health will be hosting orientations on the Core Practice Model (CPM) Guide and the Medi-Cal Documentation Manual for Intensive Care Coordination (ICC), Intensive Home-Based Services (IHBS), and Therapeutic Foster Care (TFC) for the Katie A. class members. We will be hosting a series of regional orientations across the State. These orientations are intended to provide an overview of the key values and principles of the CPM and the core components of ICC and IHBS for county child welfare and mental health staff. . In the future there will be opportunities for integrated trainings as the State moves forward to promote and support the implementation of the integrated practice between child welfare and mental health.

Core Practice Model Guide

The CPM Guide has specific values, principles, practice components, standards, and activities. It is intended to facilitate a common strategic and practical framework for integrated services planning, delivery, coordination and management among all those involved in working with foster care children with mental health needs.

Medi-Cal Manual for ICC, IHBS, and TFC for Katie A. Subclass Members

This manual provides information for developing mental health plans and for Medi-Cal providers concerning the provision of three covered specialty mental health services for those child/youth who are member of the Katie A. subclass. It provides the standards and guidelines for the delivery and billing of ICC and IHBS. (TFC will be added to this manual at a later date).
